- A. Proof of admission and registration to an accredited college or university
- B. Current photograph (a posed photo, either professional or high-resolution digital photograph on CD — no "selfies")
- C. Letter of recommendation from High School or Technical School/College/University instructor.
- D. Essay (outlined in Section IV above)

The Scholarship Award Committee may interview applicants at its discretion.
